6. MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor Rogero recognized and welcomed a group of Youth Leadership Knoxville in the audience.

The Mayor reminded everyone of the ongoing City Council election. Early voting goes through Thursday, November 2nd, 2017, and Election Day is Tuesday, November 7th, 2017.

The Mayor announced the fifth Open Streets Knoxville event for Sunday, October 29th, 2017 from 2:00pm to 6:00pm in South Knoxville along Gay Street Bridge, Council Place, and Sevier Avenue. This event is hosted by Bike Walk Knoxville.

The Mayor also announced that the University of Tennessee’s Homecoming Parade will for the first time in thirty years proceed along Cumberland Avenue on Friday,
