**WHEREAS**, the coordination of all aspects of the City of Knoxville’s youth athletic Track and Field and Cross Country programs have been administered by Knoxville Youth Athletics, LLC (formerly known as Eight Lane Consultants, LLC) for many years; and

**WHEREAS**, Knoxville Youth Athletics has been responsible for all aspects of the programs, including but not limited to managing youth meets and practices, coordinating and soliciting private and public funding sources, budget maintenance, ordering supplies/equipment and performing other related work as required; and

**WHEREAS**, all renewal options have been used with the current contract in place, therefore, the Parks and Recreation Department is requesting to extend the agreement to allow services to continue until the procurement and evaluation/selection process has been completed.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF**

**KNOXVILLE:**

**SECTION 1:** The Mayor of the City of Knoxville is hereby authorized to execute a Third Amendment, in a form substantially like the document attached hereto, between the City and Knoxville Youth Athletics, LLC to continue the coordination of all aspects of the City of Knoxville's youth athletic Track & Field and Cross Country programs for an amount not to exceed FIFTEEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE AND 50/100 DOLLARS (\$15,651.50) and to extend the term of the contract an additional six (6) months to allow services to continue until the procurement and evaluation/selection process has been completed.

**SECTION 2:** This Resolution will take effect from and after its passage, the welfare of the City requiring it.
